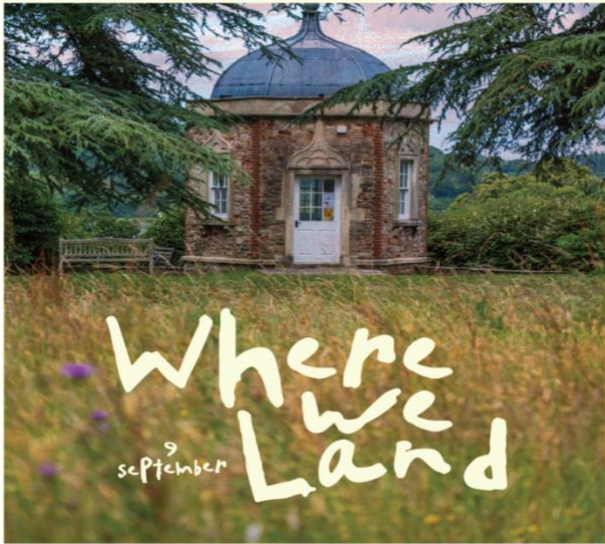


Where We Land

The event starts at 10.00am.

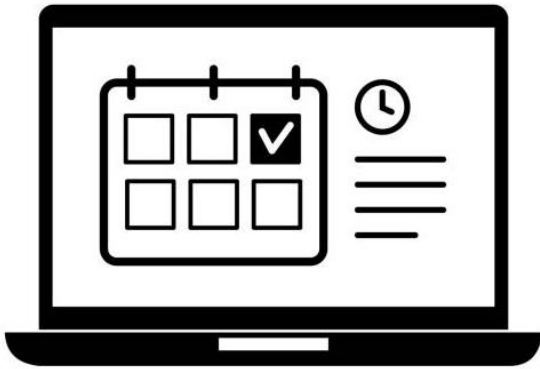
The event finishes at 4.30pm.

- Take time for yourself

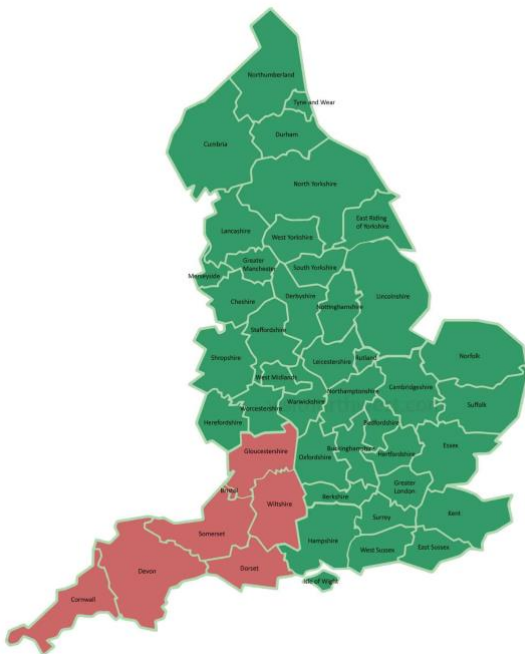
You can join in as much or as little as you want.

The venue is wheelchair accessible.

There is level access to most spaces.

2 workshop spaces are reached by a ramp.

There will be a **quiet** sensory space.

You can use this space whenever you need to.



A small number of **£75 travel bursaries** are available.
